- Carry a camera, even if it is just a cell phone.
- Take high-resolution pictures
 - You can crop later
 - Memory is cheap
- Shoot often!
- Back up your photos
 - Onto a CD or DVD
 - External HD
- Don't edit the original
 - Some programs like Lightroom do not edit the original.
- Look at lots of pictures. I mean LOTS of them. Seriously look at them, study them, and take notes.
- Read your manual three times.
 - Try EVERYTHING that is written about in the manual.
 - You don't have to do it all in the first day
 - Carry your manual in your bag.
- Don't switch cameras every year
 - Get familiar with the one you have
 - Use it
 - Know it
 - Love it
 - The photographer takes the picture, not the camera. The camera just records.
